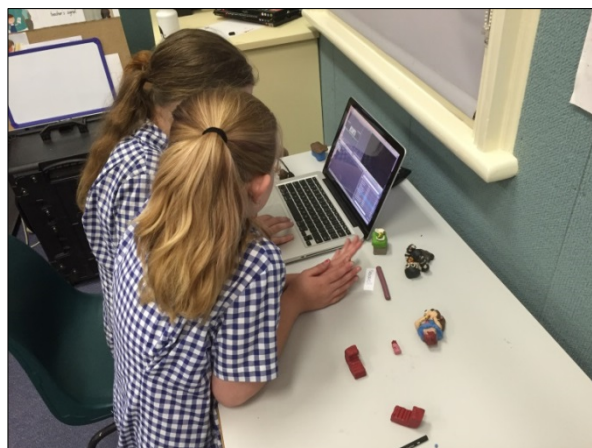

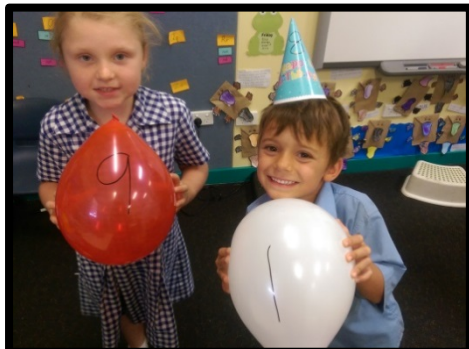
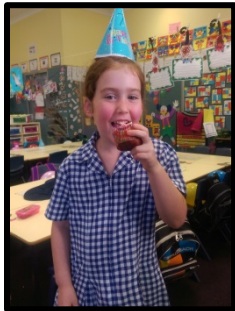


## 10's Birthday Party
