John 'JC' Coutis is a remarkable Australian who was born with a severe physical disability in which doctors gave him little chance of survival. John has not only defied medical opinion, he has thrived and is acknowledged as one of the world's most inspirational speakers. Without the lower part of his body, John embraces a full and positive life. He rolls around on his custom skateboard and uses humour to communicate some of life's most important lessons.

John has delivered his inspirational message to over six million people around the world, speaking at events to complement former US President Bill Clinton, global entrepreneur Richard Branson, former British Prime Minister Tony Blair and the late Steven Covey and former South African President Nelson Mandela.

CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW ENGLAND HIGHWAY BYPASS OF SCONE STARTS IN JULY 2018

The first stage of work will see boundary fencing installed around the project area. Access arrangements through the **Bill Rose Sporting Complex** will change, with additional pedestrian signage and crossing facilities provided to ensure safety throughout the construction period.

The existing **playground and exercise equipment** will be removed as this area is required for the bypass. The Upper Hunter Shire Council with the support of Roads and Maritime Service (RMS) will be providing the community with new equipment at a new location. Keep an eye out on Council's website at www.upperhunter.nsw.gov.au for updates on the new playground plans as part of the Bill Rose Sporting Complex Masterplan.

The **informal parking** on Aberdeen Street south of Kingdon Street will be unavailable for the duration of works due to the large number of trucks requiring access to the golf course.

Work is expected to be completed in late 2020, weather permitting.
