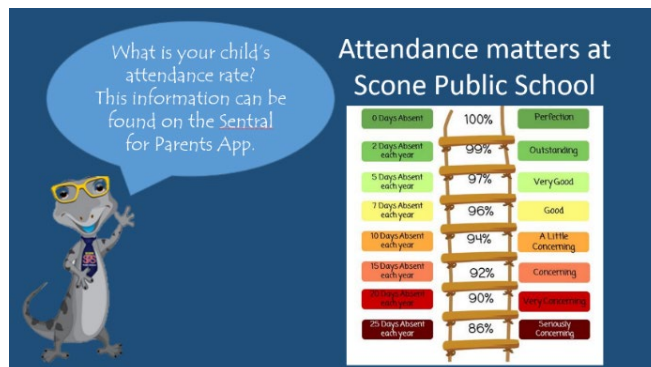
PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE
