
PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Thank you to the Year 6 Teachers for their amazing organisation and to other staff members for their participation.
























K-2 FROLICOn Friday, our infants students had a wonderful morning filled with lots of fun activities, which included a very special visit from Santa.

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
